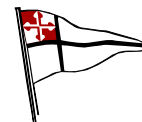

General: First run in 1929, this event will return to its original date on the Friday of Labor Day Weekend this year. It will be an interregional distance event combining a Region 2 start with Region 3 marks. Double points are awarded toward class trophies and handicap divisions for CBYRA Race Week. Event Sailing Instructions to be posted at site for CBYRA Race Week.

Rendezvous: At 1130 in the Start Area approximately 2.0 nautical miles east southeast of Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" (Baltimore Light) in vicinity of 39°02.25 N 76°21.41.6 W.

Start: Between orange flag on RC boat and Region 2 Mark "U" (inflatable drop mark).

Signals: RRS 26 as modified below. It is the intention of the RC to provide rolling starts.

Divisions may sail different courses. PHRF One Design Classes with 5 entries or more may be given a separate start. Be alert for several class flags being displayed during start sequence for combined starts.

Course: Generally, from start in Region 2 to Finish in Region 3 via other Region 3 marks - passing east of Sandy Point Light and Thomas Point Light; and west of Sharp's Island light in both directions. In the event of light winds the RC will shorten the course.

Finish: Between orange flag on RC boat and Region 3 mark "X" (R2). RC boat will fly a vertical hoist of three red lights after dark.

Time Limit: None. However the intention is for all yachts to complete the course within 6 hours.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7+ finishers. The Cedar Point Cup will be awarded to the yacht with the best corrected average speed. Presentations held at the Labor Day Awards Dinner for CBYRA Race Week. Results will be posted: www.cbyra.org.

Protests: Verbally notify RC boat at finish. All protests must be submitted in writing to CBYRA RC headquarters within one hour of the docking time of the Signal Boat.

Other: There will be free mooring at GIYS for registered yachts from Thursday to Saturday 1200.
