## Notice of Team Race

### Gibson Island Yacht Squadron

Saturday 15 October 2011



- General:** The Maryland Club Yacht Squadron (MCYS) has challenged the Gibson Island Yacht Squadron (GIYS) to a Team Race series of races for the Crossland Cup. The challenge was accepted by GIYS. GIYS is the organizing authority for the event.
- Event:** This will be a Team Race event under Appendix D of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The series may be an Umpired event.
- Race Date:** Saturday, October 15, 2011.
- Location:** Waters of the Magothy River in the vicinity of Gibson Island, MD.
- Teams:** GIYS and MCYS shall each field 3 teams of three sailors per team. Alternates are permitted at the discretion of each club, however three sailors (including skipper) shall crew any one boat during racing. Skippers and crew representing GIYS shall be members in good standing of GIYS and likewise for MCYS.

- Rendezvous:** Rendezvous at 0830 at the GIYS Boathouse
- Boats:** Boats will be GIYS International 210s. Spinnakers will not be used. Boat assignment will be drawn by lot. The possibility of a boat breakdown and its potential effect on scoring will be covered in the Sailing Instructions.
- Course:** Course will be a Digital "P". Leg distances will be adjusted to suit wind conditions. The course may not be shortened by eliminating a leg of the course. This changes rule 32.1; however, a race may be abandoned under rule 32.1
- Scoring:** This will be a best of 5 race series with a minimum of 3 races to be completed to qualify as a series.
- Time Limit:** No start after 1600. A race will have no time limit but the course legs will be set for an estimated 30 minute time period to sail the course.
- Awards:** The Crossland Cup
- Social:** Open Bar following the race. Mooring at GIYS for both Friday and Saturday nights is available for non- members at \$38 per night or at dockside for \$65.00 per night. Sailors and spectators are invited to attend the Oyster Roast (\$55.00 per person) at the Gibson Island Club on Saturday evening. Reservations for the Oyster Roast must be made in advance with the Gibson Island Club (410-255-1000).
