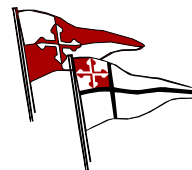

Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:

PHRF A0/A1	PHRF SB	J/30
PHRF B/C	PHRF N	J/35
PHRF A2	Club Class*	J/105

* Non-sanctioned

Each class must have a minimum entry of 3 boats entered.

Rendezvous: At 0900 in vicinity of Region 3 Mark A. Check-in with RC boat is required.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on SCC RC boat and nearby orange mark.

Signals: Warning at 1000.
Starting sequence will be given in the Event Sailing Instructions as posted on the websites of SCC (<http://www.scc1944.org>) and GIYS (www.gibsonisland.com/yachtsquadron/).

Course: A distance race of 10 – 30NM around CBYRA Regions 2 & 3 marks is anticipated, depending on conditions on the day of the event. The course will be given in the Event Sailing Instructions as posted on the websites of SCC (<http://www.scc1944.org>) and GIYS (www.gibsonisland.com/yachtsquadron/).

Each entrant must print a copy of the Event Sailing Instructions for their own use.

Finish: Between yellow flag on GIYS RC boat and nearby inflatable mark, in the vicinity of the Magothy River entrance, unless course has been shortened after start.

Time Limit: Saturday 1600. Any yacht not finishing within 1 hour after the first finisher in their class will be awarded a DNF. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Protests: Due at Gibson Island Yacht Squadron Boathouse within 3 hours of protesting yacht's finish. Protests hearing will start at 1800 on Friday 27. May 2011 at the Annapolis Yacht Club, 2 Compromise Street, Annapolis, MD. Check in with the front office for the specific location for the hearing..

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7, 4th/10+ starters. Awards will be presented at the Saturday post-race party.

Social: The Gibson Island Yacht Squadron and Sailing Club of the Chesapeake will host a "Denver's Dock Party" at 1730 on Saturday 21 May 2011 at the GIYS Boathouse following the race. Entry Fee covers Skipper and three crew; \$10 fee for additional crew; food, free keg and cash bar. Free overnight mooring and tender service for competitors. Contact GIYS Harbormaster on VHF 78A for mooring assignment or rafting instructions. For arrivals by car, contact GIYS Harbormaster *in advance* at 410.255.7632.
